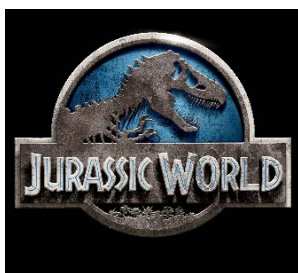




## Jurassic World
